Northside College Prep proudly encourages and supports all students who elect to represent the school. As part of the Northside community, we each reflect upon not only ourselves, but our team or club, and our entire school in all that we do. Because the impact of our actions reflect so widely, we acknowledge that we hold ourselves to a high standard.

It is understood that all student representatives of Northside must follow

- All federal, state and local laws,
- CPS and school rules,
- Any rules established by an organization or institution hosting an event in which we are participating, and
- Any rules established by the athletic handbook or by a club in conjunction with their sponsor.

Additionally, we realize that representing Northside is a privilege and that failing any classes or even having three or more D's at any time during the school year, will preclude me from participating in clubs or school teams. We know that it is important to, at all times, conduct ourselves with maturity, integrity and sportsmanship.

Such rules are applicable whenever we represent Northside in our official capacity or participate in activities sponsored by Northside.

Failure to represent myself, my team or club, and my school with appropriate behavior may jeopardize my opportunity to participate in school sponsored activities. Additionally, any misconduct will be dealt with in accordance with the procedures laid out in the above codes and in conjunction with the discussions between ourselves, our parents, our coaches and other relevant individuals.

Because our coach is the touch-point and sponsor for our team or club, we acknowledge that our coach (and in the case of athletics, our athletic director) has the authority to decide matters of membership, participation, and other team or club related privilege.

The coach has the responsibility to notify the administration whenever action is taken on account of a violation of this contract or sees behavior that, according to the above codes, warrants a larger set of consequences than they are authorized to give.
